

Government Decree No. 2017-390 of March 9, 2017, establishing the creation, organization, and operating procedures of a management unit tasked with achieving the objectives of the project to revise authorizations for the exercise of economic activities and setting the Tunisian classification of activities.

The Head of Government,

On the proposal of the Minister of Development, Investment, and International Cooperation,

Having regard to the Constitution,

Having regard to Law No. 83-112 of December 12, 1983, on the general status of State, local authority, and public administrative institution personnel, as amended and supplemented by subsequent texts, in particular Decree-Law No. 2011-89 of September 23, 2011,

Having regard to Law No. 99-32 of April 13, 1999, on the national statistics system, and in particular Articles 4, 10, and 18 thereof,

Having regard to Law No. 2015-33 of August 17, 2015, establishing senior civil service positions in accordance with the provisions of Article 92 of the Constitution,

Having regard to Law No. 2016-71 of September 30, 2016, on investment, as amended by Law No. 2017-1 of January 3, 2017, on the supplementary finance law for 2016, and in particular Articles 2 and 4 thereof,

Having regard to Decree No. 94-780 of April 4, 1994, establishing the national business register,

Having regard to Decree No. 96-1236 of July 6, 1996, establishing management units by objectives,

Having regard to Decree No. 99-2797 of December 13, 1999, establishing the composition, organization, and operating procedures of the National Statistics Council, as amended and supplemented by subsequent texts, in particular Decree No. 2004-2659 of November 29, 2004,

Having regard to Decree No. 2006-1245 of April 24, 2006, establishing the system for the allocation and withdrawal of central administration functional posts,

Having regard to Decree No. 2014-3484 of September 18, 2014, on the establishment of a participatory process for the simplification of administrative procedures governing economic activities and falling within the remit of the Ministries of the Interior, Equipment, Regional Planning and Sustainable Development, Tourism, and Health,

Having regard to Government Decree No. 2016-1164 of August 10, 2016, on the organization of the Ministry of Development, Investment, and International Cooperation,

Having regard to Presidential Decree No. 2016-107 of August 27, 2016, appointing the head of government and its members,

Having regard to the order of the Minister of Industry and Technology of September 15, 2010, repealing the order of the Minister of Industry of July 2, 1996, approving the Tunisian standard relating to the classification of activities,

Having regard to the opinion of the Administrative Court,

After deliberation by the Council of Ministers. Issues the following government decree:

Article 1 - This government decree sets out the provisions relating to:

- the creation of a management unit responsible for achieving the objectives of the project to revise the authorizations for the exercise of economic activities within the framework of the application of Article 4 of the aforementioned Investment Law,

- the Tunisian classification of activities provided for in Article 2 of the aforementioned Investment Law.

TITLE I

The management unit responsible for implementing the project to review authorizations for economic activities

Art. 2 - An objective-based management unit shall be created within the ministry responsible for investment to carry out the project to revise authorizations for the exercise of economic activities.

Art. 3 - The management unit shall be responsible, in coordination with the ministries and structures involved in the investment operation, for the following in particular:

- studying and evaluating all legal and regulatory texts relating to the exercise of economic activities, as well as proposing and monitoring the implementation of reforms likely to enshrine the principle of freedom of investment provided for in Article 4 of the Investment Law,

- developing a program to review investment operation authorizations, either by eliminating them or replacing them with specifications in accordance with the principle of investment liberalization;

- Revise and simplify the procedure for granting authorizations that are maintained.

- revise and update the provisions of the specifications for economic activities with a view to enshrining the principles of simplification of procedures and freedom of investment,

- draft the government decree provided for in Article 4 of the aforementioned investment law and relating to:

- establishing the list of activities subject to authorization and the list of administrative authorizations required to carry out a project, the deadlines, procedures, and conditions for granting them,

- establishing the list of activities exempt from the principle of silence.

- drafting legal and regulatory texts relating to the abolition of authorizations or their replacement by specifications in coordination with the relevant administrative structures,

- developing a guide on the list of authorizations and specifications for all economic activities, specifying in particular the procedure for granting them, the documents required, the structures responsible for granting them, and the deadlines for responding to requests for authorizations,

- monitor the implementation of the program to review authorizations for the exercise of economic activities by the relevant administrative bodies and work to ensure that the expected objectives are rigorously achieved.

Art. 4 - The duration of the work of the management unit by objective is set at three years from the date of entry into force of this government decree. This period comprises two phases:

First phase: This phase shall last for one year from the date of entry into force of this government decree and shall include, in particular:

- the completion of studies and evaluations of all legal and regulatory texts relating to the exercise of economic activities subject to authorization, as well as administrative authorizations to carry out a project, deadlines, procedures, and conditions for their granting,

- establishing the list of activities subject to authorization and the list of administrative authorizations required to carry out a project, the deadlines, procedures, and conditions for granting them, and drafting the relevant government decree in accordance with the provisions of Article 4 of the Investment Law;

- the development of a program to eliminate authorizations or replace them with specifications, as well as a timetable for implementation.

This phase must be concluded with the preparation of a report containing concrete recommendations and proposals for simplifying and reducing authorization procedures.

Second Phase: This phase will last two years from the end date of the first phase and will include, in particular:

- the implementation of the program to simplify authorization procedures, their removal, or their replacement with specifications in accordance with the schedule set during the first phase of the management unit's work,

- drafting legal and regulatory texts relating to the abolition of authorizations or their replacement by specifications in coordination with the relevant administrative structures,

- the revision and updating of specifications relating to the exercise of economic activities,

- the development of a guide on the list of authorizations and specifications for all economic activities, specifying in particular the procedure for granting them, the documents required, the structures responsible for granting them, and the deadlines for responding to requests for authorizations.

Art. 5 - The results of the work of the management unit by objectives shall be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- compliance with the project implementation deadlines in accordance with the provisions of Article 4 of this government decree,

- achievement of the project's expected objectives,
- the degree of completion of the annual work programs of the management unit by objectives,

- the degree of implementation of the recommendations of the project monitoring and steering committee established in accordance with Article 7 of this government decree,

- difficulties hindering implementation and measures taken to resolve them,

- the efficiency of the intervention to regulate the pace of implementation.

Art. 6 - The unit comprises the following functional positions:

- the head of the unit, with the position and benefits of a director general of central administration,

- two executives with the position and benefits of a central administration director,

- two executives with the position and benefits of deputy director of central administration.

Art. 7 - A commission chaired by the Minister responsible for investment or his representative shall be established within the Ministry responsible for investment, tasked with monitoring the missions entrusted to the above-mentioned unit and evaluating them in accordance with the criteria defined in Article 5 of this government decree.

The commission shall be composed of members representing the ministries and public bodies concerned by the authorizations, including a representative of the ministry responsible for the civil service and governance.

The members of the commission shall be appointed by order of the Minister responsible for investment.

The chair of the commission may, if necessary, call upon any person whose opinion is deemed useful to participate in its work, including representatives of the ministries and structures concerned, as well as any other body, organization, or association concerned with the field of investment.

The commission meets at the request of its chair at least once every three months and whenever necessary. It may only deliberate in the presence of at least half of its members. If the quorum is not reached, the commission will be convened to meet a second time within the following fifteen days. In this case, its deliberations will be considered legal regardless of the number of members present.

The commission issues its opinion by a majority vote of the members present. In the event of a tie, the chairperson of the commission has the casting vote.

The minister responsible for investment shall submit an annual report to the head of government on the activities of the management unit.

Art. 8 - The unit may call upon the expertise and skills of civil servants, local authorities, public institutions and enterprises, who shall be appointed by decision of the Minister responsible for investment on the advice of their administrative superiors.

It may also call upon experts and skills from the private sector as needed, who shall be appointed by decision of the minister responsible for investment.

The president of the unit may, if necessary, call upon representatives of the ministries and structures concerned, as well as representatives of any other body, organization, or association involved in the field of investment.

TITLE II

The Tunisian Classification of Activities

Art. 9 - The Tunisian classification of activities is the single, up-to-date national reference system for all economic activities. It enables them to be classified in all sectors according to categories that are harmonized at the national level and comparable at the international level, in particular through the codification of the activities of economic enterprises and the development of statistical databases relating to economic and social activities.

Art. 10 - The Tunisian classification of economic activities aims in particular to:

- grouping and classifying economic and social information according to activities for statistical purposes and in accordance with unified criteria,
- exchange harmonized data between public and private structures,
- facilitate the conduct of analytical studies and statistical comparisons at the national and international levels.

Art. 11 - The Tunisian classification of activities consists of the following elements:

- the general framework: it sets the objectives for adopting the classification and determines the definitions and terminology enabling its effective application in order to ensure its harmonization with comparable international classifications,
- the detailed structure: this determines the structure and coding system adopted to digitize the different categories of the classification,
- Explanatory notes: these clarify the content and scope of the categories in the classification.

The detailed structure of the 2009 Tunisian classification of activities is annexed to this government decree.

Art. 12 - The National Institute of Statistics is responsible for:

- providing technical assistance to the public bodies concerned in applying the Tunisian classification of activities through training and assistance with codification,
- updating the Tunisian classification of activities and revising it in coordination with the structures concerned within the framework of a steering committee to be created for this purpose.

Public bodies are required to take all necessary measures and use all necessary tools to adopt the Tunisian Classification of Activities as the sole classification for their activities and to take the necessary measures to revise the data concerning them in accordance with the attached classification within a maximum period of two years from the date of publication of this government decree.

The National Institute of Statistics is responsible for assessing the degree of use of the Tunisian classification of activities among the public bodies concerned.

Art. 13 - The regulatory texts relating to the updating of the Tunisian classification of activities shall be drawn up by the National Institute of Statistics and submitted to the National Statistics Council for its opinion.

Art. 14 - The Minister of Development, Investment, and International Cooperation and the Minister of Finance shall be responsible, each in their respective areas of competence, for the implementation of this government decree, which shall be published in the Official Journal of the Republic of Tunisia.
